You will have noticed the western entrance to St Peter's Garden is roped off. This is a safety issue as we are again having problems with the weather-vanes on the tower pinnacles. The 'tail' of the SE one broke off and was found at the base of the tower. The 'tail' of the NW one has been bent through 90 degrees and a crack is starting to appear. We are in touch with steeplejacks to resolve the problem. 3 quotes have been received, ranging from £3,975 to £1,098, all +VAT. Work has been provisionally booked to take place on the morning of Saturday 6th August. This should not impact on the wedding to take place that afternoon. *Roger & John*
